
# ORANGE SEDGE 'PRAIRIE FIRE'

Height and Spread: 1ft by 1ft

Growing Habit: Dense, clumping, likes well drained soil

Sun Exposure: Full to part sun



# BLACK MONDO GRASS

Height and Spread: Clumps 5-6 inches tall and wide Sun Exposure: Full sun to partial shade (deer resistant)



#### YELLOW LOOSESTRIFE

Producing sturdy upright brilliant flower stems, Yellow Loosestrife is a perennial with extremely beautiful flower stalks that attract butterflies and bees. They are prolific bloomers and act as a great ground cover in beds and borders. These showy flowering plants are easy to grow and spread quickly providing great ornamental value in a garden. They are long lasting cut flowers and vigorous rhizome producers, thriving in full sun.

Height and Spread: 1-2 feet

Sun Exposure: full to partial sun



### SWORD FERN

Broadleaf evergreen or semi-evergreen that has large, arching, dark green, erect fronds that are born from a crown of scaly rhizomes. The plant grows to a height of 3 to 4 feet tall and 2 to 4 feet wide.

Sun Exposure: Prefers partial to full shade in moist, well-drained acidic soils.



#### SEDUM 'NEON'

Easily grown in average, dry to medium, well-drained soils in full sun. Thrives in sandy to gravelly soils of moderate to low fertility.

Sun Exposure: full sun

Water: Dry to medium

Attracts pollinators. (not deer resistant)



#### GIANT LAMBS EAR

Forms a low mound of large, velvety soft, silver-green foliage that has a lamb's-ear shape. Foliage is twice the size of regular lamb's ear. Pink spike blooms. Very drought resistant when established in well-drained soil.

Height: 8 – 10 IN

Sun Exposure: full sun, partial shade

(deer, rabbit, and drought resistant)



#### **EPIMEDIUM**

Yellow epimedium is a clump-forming rhizomatous evergreen ground cover. It prefers light to moderate shade and does well in any well-drained garden soil. It is drought tolerant once established so tolerates being planted under trees. It forms a dense ground cover that will help block weed growth.

Sun Exposure: sun or partially shaded location.



### **LUNGWORT**

Lungwort is a charming garden perennial with soft, speckled green leaves and clusters of drooping blue, pink, and/or white flowers. Lungwort prefers shady locations with consistently moist but well-drained soils and grow to 30 cm tall. It does not tolerate full sun.

Sun Exposure: shade to partial shade



### HIMALAYAN HONEYSUCKLE

A multi-caned deciduous shrub in the honeysuckle family that typically grows to 3-6' tall. Easily grown in average, moist but well-drained soils in full sun to part shade.

Shrub stems will typically freeze to the ground in winter when temperatures dip below 15 degrees F, but new stems will likely rise up from a protected root system in spring and rapidly grow back to as much as 6' tall by summer. Noteworthy Characteristics:

Flowers are followed by small fleshy edible purple berries which purportedly taste like toffee or caramel.

Sun Exposure: full sun to part shade

(not deer resistant)



# SALVIA INVOLUCRATA 'BETHELLII'

A broadleaf evergreen perennial with pink flowers in spring and winter. Attractive to hummingbirds and beneficial insects.

Prefers sun - bright shade and regular water. Grows happily in well-drained soil. Blooms July to November.

Sun Exposure: sun to part sun

Approx 4' x 4'



#### <u>HOSTA</u>

A dependable and versatile perennial requiring little care. Dense foliage crowds out garden weeds.

Sun Exposure: shade to partial shade

(not deer resistant)



# ENGLISH LAVENDAR

English lavender is an evergreen shrub with a compact, bushy growth habit. It typically grows 1 to 3 feet tall and wide.

Sun Exposure: full sun

(deer resistant, attracts pollinators)



# **ROSE CAMPION**

Rose campion is an old-fashioned favourite that adds brilliant magenta colour to the flower garden.

Sun Exposure: full sun to part shade

(deer resistant, pollinator)



#### **MULLIEN**

Renowned for it's medicinal properties Mullien serves as a striking focal point in gardens. This biennial sets out a beautiful large rosette in it's first year, and a tall (up to 7ft) flower stalk covered in yellow flowers the following year.

Sun Exposure: full sun

(deer resistant, attracts pollinators)
